<p>Since there is no working draft attached to the proposal, the proposal does not comply with the clause 2.3.4 of ISO/IEC Directives, Part 1, which says that the originator of the new work item proposal shall make every effort to provide a first working draft for discussion, or shall at least provide an outline of such a working draft. We cannot judge it gives the sufficient definition of the new work item. For example, the following questions should be answered. - What kind of technology is applied to the issue? - What is to be standardized? encryption method? protocol in software market? - Can the technology be applied to any programming language without changing the language per se? - Does the technology assume a general and conceptual infrastructure or a specific one available now?</p>
